Please accept my apologies for the delay in replying to you.

Freedom of Information Internal Review - Reference No: 20192292

Following your email of 17 October 2019, I accept that the contents of the email constitute an appeal following an expression of dissatisfaction following the response that was sent to you on the 9 October 2019. In my position as the Deputy Information Compliance Officer, I am independent of the original decision making process.

In relation to your question, I have made additional enquiries and I can confirm that as part of a trial of AFR at Meadowhall Shopping Centre, South Yorkshire Police provided four images from South Yorkshire Police records. These consisted of three individuals who were wanted for serious offences whose details were already in the public domain and one highly vulnerable missing person, the missing person was found from this image. The images were deleted after the four week period and no further information has been provided to Meadowhall.

I hope that this clarifies your query, if you are still dissatisfied with how your request has been handled, you can raise this with the Information Commissioner.
